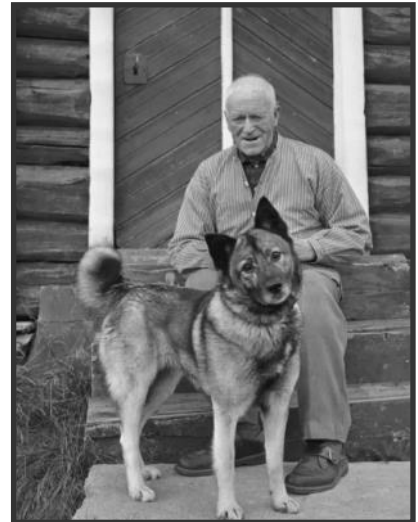

Library Corner

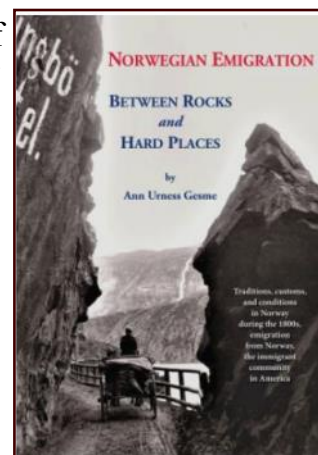
