

CONVENTION 2020 CULTURAL DAY



The purpose of Cultural Day is: to provide members with a better knowledge and understanding of their heritage; to allow each lodge to earn some money; to provide the Daughters of Norway better visibility in the community. The public will be invited. The Convention 2020 Committee has chosen to allow outside vendors, encouraging Scandinavian items.

All lodges are encouraged to reserve a table for sales, demonstrations, or an exhibit. Lodge banners and scrapbooks may be displayed and individual lodges may sell tickets for one drawing per lodge. Ten percent of the sales, including sales of drawing tickets sold at convention, are remitted to the Grand Lodge. Winners of all lodge table drawing items will be announced following Saturday Lunch. All tickets should have cell # and name, “need not be present to win”, and may be sold until Saturday Lunch begins. Lodge drawing items may be displayed in foyer outside the dining room until Saturday Lunch begins.

Major trip and large drawing items will be drawn at the Saturday Banquet.

All lodges are also encouraged to contribute a donation to the Thursday Evening Silent Auction, proceeds to be divided between the three hosting lodges in support of convention expenses.
